

Printing with Muncicity Android

There are a few requirements that must be met to be able to print from your Android device with Muncicity Android. You will need the following things:

- The PrinterShare App
- A Bluetooth-capable printer. Three possible models are: [HP Officejet Mobile 100](#), [Brother Pocketjet 6](#), or the HP Deskjet 460 (discontinued, but available from some websites); a list of other PrinterShare-compatible printers is available at: <http://www.printershare.com/help-mobile-supported.sdf>
- NOTE: This list also contains printers that are intended to connect to the device through WiFi. While this is a possible way to get Muncicity Android to print, this is NOT a method recommended OR supported by SCA.
- (Optional) Adobe Acrobat Reader for Android

Once you have the basic requirements:

1. You will need to pair your Bluetooth printer to your Android device. Follow the instructions in your printer's manual to activate its Bluetooth connection, and then go into your Android's settings menu.
2. Choose the Wireless & Networks option to find your device's Bluetooth settings. Check the box to activate Bluetooth, and then use the "Scan for devices" button to search for your printer.
3. Once your device finds the printer, tap the printer's name in the list of Bluetooth devices at the bottom of the screen.
4. Once your Android and printer are paired, go to the PrinterShare app to get it to recognize your printer. In the app, hit the menu button and choose the "Nearby Printers (BT)" option to set up its connection to your printer.
5. In the menu that pops up, tap the "Scan for Printers" button to find your printer. Once it is found, PrinterShare will ask you to install the drivers for your printer. Select yes to complete the printer's installation.
6. Now that the installation is complete, you can print from Muncicity Android using PrinterShare. To do this, tap the "Inspection Printout" on the inspection that you want to print.
7. A menu labeled "Complete action using" will pop up. Tap PrinterShare to be able to print the document. PrinterShare will open with a preview of your document. Tap the print button and select your desired page range to send the document to the printer.
